







It fills the gap between pharmacologic management of pain & more invasive operative procedure.

What is interventional pain management?

- Interventional pain management or interventional pain medicine is a super-specialty of the medical specialty pain medicine, devoted to decrease or eliminate pain with use of invasive & non invasive techniques
 - This can be accomplished in following ways:
 - Interrupting the pain signal along a neural pathway
 - Remodeling anatomical source of pain
 - Neuroaugmentation (SCS, PNS)
 - Implantable drug delivery system









Treatment ladder (Modified....)

The Chronic Pain Treatment Continuum












STEP UP ALGORITHM















Implantable intrathecal infusion pump








Sympathetic nerve block








Trigger point injection







Deep brain stimulation








Epidural nerve block
