<p>Objective</p> <p>Lectures were designed for 5th year undergraduate studies students of the Faculty of Medicine, University of Belgrade, as part of the curriculum of the Desk of Surgery and Anesthesiology.</p> <p>The aim of the organization of these lectures was to raise awareness of the pain treatment with the presentation of relevant scientific facts about it.</p> <p>Therefore, the goals of organizing and maintaining this lectures could be presented in the following way:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raising the awareness of the medical students about the problem of pain, • Getting acquainted with the use of ketamine in the treatment of pain • Getting acquainted with the digital media presentation of alternative Pain Management • Highlighting the significance of the HEPMP project with all its goals and activities, • The dissemination of information about HEPMP, its objectives and activities, • Through the dissemination of HEPMP information, the call to all students to participate in HEPMP activities through participation in the project forum. 	

Description of activities

Because of the epidemiological measures, during two days, the lectures were presented via Zoom platform and organized by University Clinical Center "Dr Dragiša Mišović-Dedinje". The June 1st, 20 students were present at the meeting, and second day (June 2nd) 18 students were present. Lectures were held for 5th year students of the Medical Faculty in Belgrade. A total of 30 students attended the classes. Both days Prof. dr Vladimir Djukic was presenting lectures.

Lecturer's work was prepared in the form of 2 presentations, which enable listeners to get familiar with the pain-related issues in detail. At the June 2nd lecture was in English so students who are in English study group were able to follow. All presentations were sent to students by mail in order to use them for long term learning.

At the end of the lecture there was a brief discussion in which the lecturer and the students join together.

Students were invited via mail, and the registration list from the Zoom meeting was transferred into the attendance list form.
