<p><b>Objective</b></p> <p>Lectures, exercises and seminars were designed by the Desk of Anesthesiology, and within 9 semesters of undergraduate studies of students of the Faculty of Medicine, University of Belgrade, as part of the curriculum of the Desk of Surgery and Anesthesiology.</p> <p>For the past years, the Anesthesiology program for the 9th semester of student (undergraduate) teaching in the Surgery with Anesthesiology Desk at the Medical Faculty in Belgrade lasted for 3 weeks. For the first time, the Desk of Anesthesiology received an additional two weeks of space for presenting new topics in undergraduate education. It was decided that one lecture be "Chronic Pain".</p> <p>The aim of the organization of these lectures was to raise awareness of the problem of pain with the presentation of relevant scientific facts about pain.</p> <p>Therefore, the goals of organizing and maintaining these lectures could be presented in the following way:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Raising the awareness of the medical students about the problem of pain,</li> <li>• Getting acquainted with the epidemiology of pain, through it with the significance of the problem and the need to learn about it at the Faculty of Medicine in undergraduate education,</li> <li>• Getting acquainted with the anatomical and pathophysiological basics of pain with an explanation of the way of seeing pain in medicine today,</li> <li>• Getting to know how to review patient with pain,</li> <li>• Presentation of basic therapeutic modalities, with a focus on opioid analgesic therapy in malignant and non-malignant pain,</li> <li>• Explain the concepts of opioidophobia and addiction, as well as to get to know the</li> </ul>	

potential fears of doctors and patients,

- Highlighting the significance of the HEPMP project with all its goals and activities,
- The dissemination of information about HEPMP, its objectives and activities,
- Through the dissemination of HEPMP information, the call to all students to participate in HEPMP activities through participation in the project forum.

### **Description of activities**

During one working week (5 working days) at the Clinic for Anesthesiology and Intensive Care of the University Clinical Center "Dr Dragiša Mišović-Dedinje", the teaching bases of the Medical Faculty of the University of Belgrade were held between October 19 and 23, 2018, from 08.00 to 13.00. lectures, seminars and exercises for students of the 9th semester of the Medical Faculty in Belgrade. Every other day, another group of students was listening to the classes (listed in the enclosure). A total of 107 students attended the classes.

From 08-10h, a lecture was held with the topic "Chronic Pain". After a half-hour break, a seminar was held for an hour and then exercises until 13h.

Lecturer's work is prepared in the the form of lecture, which enable listeners to get acquainted with the pain-related issues in detail. On the 146 slides in lecture and 25 slides in seminar, the selected aspects of the problem of pain have been processed and thus enabled the reader to gain insights into specific aspects of the pain problem in one place. Both lectures were sent to students by mail in order to use them for long term learning.

After the lecture there was a short discussion in which the lecturers and the audience were taken together.

At the end of each day, students completed the Annex 7 HEPMP-Self-evaluation list of training for STUDENT on the 5th year BU, which was later analyzed, and the results are attached to this report.
